FOREWORD

To my beloved daughter Lien who died far too early

In JUNE 1963, MR A. DELMONTE wrote in the foreword to his book *The Golden Benelux*: 'We hope that the publication of this book will stimulate the already intensive collecting of the coins of our provinces and that this book may help both current and future interested parties to get a complete overview of the golden and rich numismatic past'. These words were more than realized and were the main reason for this publication.

More than 2000 years ago, the Celts produced the first gold coins in our regions. It was the beginning of a vast series of gold coins. Each gold coin is a precious, artistic and attractive historical document to everyone's eye. Especially for local history, these golden pieces can represent a story of wars, international contacts and exceptional economic prosperity as well as hard times. With their artistic designs, some medieval coin series are among the most beautiful in Europe and are highly sought for.

This book is designed for collectors and dealers. The book gives an overview of all types of gold coins that have been produced in the Low Countries over the past 23 centuries. The demarcation of the scope and the terrain has led to the title *The Gold Coinage of the Low Countries*. The borders of countries and regions have undergone major changes during this period, as a result of which the inclusion or exclusion of certain coins has sometimes been arbitrary. The Low Countries refer to the historical areas that were under the influence of the local rulers mainly on the current territory of the Benelux (Belgium, The Netherlands and Luxembourg) and some in the Northern part of France.

The most important information is given for each type of coin or gold strike: the province or issuing authority, denomination, mint, a picture or line drawing of the coin, a brief description of the obverse and the reverse design, the complete legends of the coin pictured, dates known, rarity, and price estimate. Collecting the images of some prestigious coins and of the beautiful but extremely rare off-metal strikes in gold was quite a challenge on its own. Some images from old publications or auction catalogues are colored which is indicated by ★ next to the image. As well as in a few cases silver coins were colored when gold specimen were not available for picturing, indicated by the same symbol ★.

This publication is the final result of common efforts between John Saunders and myself. Thanks to numismatist and private collector J. Saunders, it was possible to make a thorough study of this gold coinage and to obtain most of the pictures. Mr Saunders is the driving force and provider of additional information for the collectors such as rarity and a collector's value. The values are 2023 data and can change quickly as the collection market develops.

And of course, many words of thanks and appreciation go out to all collectors, professional numismatists, coin dealers and institutions that have contributed to the creation of this book. Deserve a special mention:
